- Must have a 3.5 GPA
- Plan to enroll in an accredited institution within the US
- Due Date: **Jan 31st, 2017**
 - Application form (with details about ALD membership)
 - Report Test Scores
 - 500 word essay on value of ALD/membership
 - 500 word essay on future professional objectives
 - Letters of recommendation 72-3; 1 must be a faculty member
- Recipients are announced April 30th, 2017

- Plan to study abroad in a US-based institutional programs (Summer 2017 ●Spring 2018)

 - 2 letters of recommendation from the University ●1 must be a faculty member and the other can be staff
 - 250 word essay describing impact of ALD
 - 250 word essay describing goals for studies abroad and how the experience will impact personal/academic growth
